

# Are you cool or just off the wall?



Are you brave enough to take part in the next Cool Wall contest? *BD* and the organisers of the 100% Detail exhibition are looking for workplace projects for inclusion in a quick-fire public debate later this month.

The designers of the best 10 projects submitted will be invited to present their scheme to a public audience and compete for top billing on our Cool Wall. The event – the third *BD*/100% Detail Cool Wall contest – will take place between 2pm and 4pm on Sunday September 24 at Earls Court 1, and will be covered in *BD* and on *bdonline*.

Following a light-hearted lively debate with heckling and

banter in the style of BBC's *Top Gear* programme, projects will be graded from totally uncool to subzero. Architecture's answer to Jeremy Clarkson, consultant Lee Mallett, will chair the proceedings with help from an expert panel to include *BD* editor Amanda Baillieu.

Projects must be for work spaces no more than three years old and we will look favourably on previously unpublished schemes. They do not need to be complete but must have received planning permission.
